



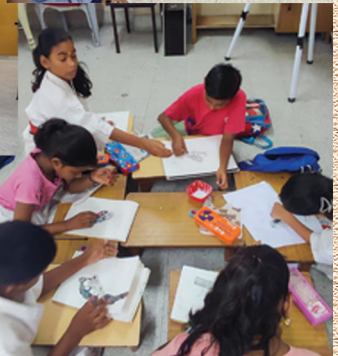

Apart from general ailments, specialized treatment is also available in the fields of Paediatrics, Ophthalmology, Dentistry, Orthopedics, Dermatology, Physiotherapy, Diabetology and Neurology. Renowned medical practitioners are attending the clinic regularly on their specified days.

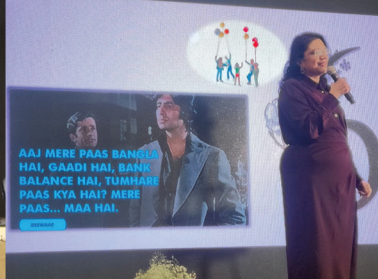
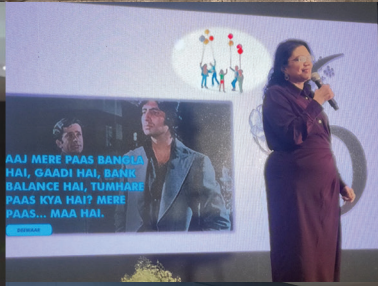

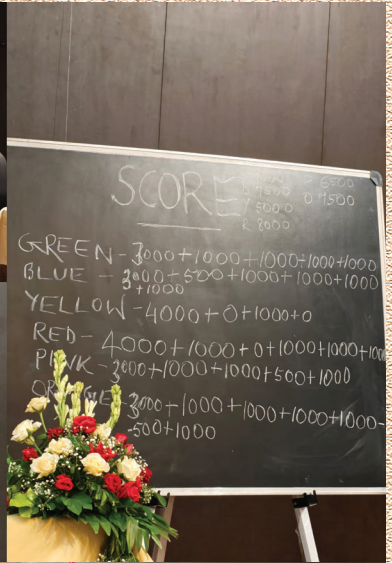
